At Foodbank WA, we believe that everyone deserves to have regular nutritious meals. We provide food and groceries to those who struggle to afford them. We also deliver nutrition education to promote healthy eating and advocate on behalf of people that experience hunger and food insecurity. We are here to support Western Australians in times of need.

Foodbank WA has an ambitious vision to end hunger in Western Australia by 2030 in line with UN Sustainable Development Goals.

We operate with a small workforce and rely on regular and corporate volunteers to help us to sort, pack and prepare food for Western Australians who need it most. Corporate volunteering is a great way to engage your staff, facilitate team building and most importantly make a difference in our community.

Last year we provided 6.7 million meals to Western Australians through our charity partners and schools. This is a staggering 300,000 more meals than the previous year. Sadly, we know that there is still an unmet gap of 30%.

The last 18 months has been a particularly challenging time with the COVID-19 pandemic, Wooroloo bushfire, Cyclone Seroja and floods in Carnarvon and Kalgoorlie.

These natural disasters have caused many Western Australians to seek help, often for the first time in their lives.

Last year, probably for the first time for most of us, the extreme pandemic-induced panic buying we witnessed at the supermarket gave us all a glimpse into the reality for those living in food poverty. Sadly, before the pandemic, empty shelves and fridges were a common occurrence for far too many Western Australians.

The pandemic increased the demand for our services by 8%. With the end of JobSeeker, JobKeeper and rent moratorium as well as the impact of the pandemic and recent natural disasters still being felt across Western Australia, we know that the demand for food assistance will continue to grow.

The day Briony made her first trip to Foodbank WA's Centre for Hunger relief, is a memory both bitter and sweet. She'd been given a ticket to survival, a fifty dollar voucher. Her rent was paid, the lights were on, she had nappies, baby Marlow had been fed, but Briony had been going without.

Three years earlier at age thirty, she never could have imagined being without food. She was fit, full of fun and loving her full time job working for an art supply specialist in Subiaco. Everything fell apart the afternoon she got a call from her doctor to come in urgently. Briony's breast cancer treatment started right away.

"People don't choose poverty. We shouldn't take anything for granted, especially after this past 18 months, there are a lot more people in this situation. Sometimes all it takes is someone filling up your pantry to give you the confidence to keep going."

Warehouse

Volunteering in our warehouse is a great option for larger groups.

In the warehouse, volunteers assist with picking, packing, sorting groceries, food and fresh produce to ensure our charity partners receive the food they need.

Volunteering in our Community Kitchen is a perfect option for smaller groups.

In our Community Kitchen, volunteers work alongside with our fully qualified Chef and help with preparing, cooking, and packing healthy frozen meals. With our full contingent of volunteers, we can distribute 1,000+ meals per week.

The Community Kitchen utilises ingredients from our Foodbank WA warehouse, which gives the food that we rescue a third life. This has helped reduce our food waste from 11% to 4%. Where essential ingredients are unavailable (such as meat and other foods rarely donated) we purchase it to provide a variety of meals.

The meals are then frozen and distributed to those who need them most through our six branches and charity partners.
